Our walk in Minor Injuries Unit opens at 08.30 and is run by experienced nurse practitioners, treating patients for:
Minor cuts, lacerations and bites (including infected wounds)

Bruises, strains and sprains

Simple fractures and dislocations

Minor burns and scalds

Head injuries (if the patient has not been unconscious)

Minor eye injuries

Splinters and other foreign bodies in the skin, eye, ear or nose

We cannot treat minor illnesses, mental health problems, injuries over two weeks old or alcohol related issues.
